The importance of service to our country was clear and the players responded with great cheers and respect.

Perhaps the highlight of the entire tournament was not the constant laughter and smiles, (mixed with highly competitive athletes) but rather the camaraderie shown throughout the day. High school students constantly jumped in and helped out with jobs during the tournament. Players and their families visited with Corporal Fox and learned about his life and challenges. Dale Downum said it best when he stated, "I feel good about the future of our world when I look around at the young people in this gym. The future is great!"
